

## **Clerk Report – December 2018 (Matters Arising)**

- 1) **Buckenham Drive Grass** – Cllr Mandy Leamon and the Clerk will be meeting with Nathan of the Grounds team at the Borough Council on site to discuss grass cutting on 29 November.
- 2) **Play Equipment** – Awaiting a response from Wormegay PC who met on 30 October to discuss bids they had received. The Clerk chased again for a response by email on 29 November.
- 3) **Children’s Centres** – The Clerk responded to the Consultation by NCC>
- 4) **Dukes Head** – A letter was sent to the Property Department at the Borough Council regarding the Dukes head on 28 October via email and the Clerk awaits a reply. The Clerk will be chasing in December.
