



## Stoke Ferry Neighbourhood Plan 2022-2036

### Adoption Statement

**Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) Section 31E (4)(b)  
Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Regulations 19 & 20**

#### BACKGROUND

Stoke Ferry Parish Council has prepared a Neighbourhood Development Plan, covering that Parish area. This has successfully passed its independent examination and a local referendum and is now being brought into force by the Borough Council (as the local planning authority for the area). The Stoke Ferry Neighbourhood Plan 2022-2036 will now form part of the development plan for the whole of the Parish of Stoke Ferry and be used to help guide development and make decisions on planning applications in Stoke Ferry Parish.

#### DECISION

The Borough Council decided on **29 August 2023** to 'make' (adopt or bring into legal force) the Stoke Ferry Neighbourhood Development Plan, as approved at referendum, with effect from **29 August 2023**.

#### REASON

The amended (referendum version) Stoke Ferry Neighbourhood Development Plan meets the Basic Conditions and other legal requirements and was supported by a majority of votes in a local referendum held on 24 August 2023.
